



The Gardens of Lincolnshire

Day by day itinerary

Day 1 Sunday 26th June 2022

Pick up from Edgworth at 0830 followed by Bromley Cross and then make our way to the first visit of the tour at Hall Farm Garden near Gainsborough, a 3 acre delight, centred round the former farmhouse. From here we head to Doddington Hall and Gardens, with time for lunch (not included) and a visit to the Elizabethan Manor House and its historic gardens, which remain faithful to the original Elizabethan layout. Then to our hotel in the heart of Lincoln for a three night stay on dinner, bed and breakfast basis.

Day 2 Monday 27th June 2022

Two wonderful nurseries first today as we head to Woodlands Plants at Fotherby, a superb nursery and garden with unusual and beautifully cared for plants. From here we will head to the Fern Nursery at Binbrook, which (as its name suggests) is renowned for its ferns. Our final visit of the day is the Goltho Gardens and Nursery, a 4.5 acre garden, dubbed "one of the great gardens of the future" in Lincolnshire Life. A packed lunch (at an extra cost of £11pp) can be provided today as the visits are to remote places with few dining options. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 3 Tuesday 28th June 2022

Today we head first over the Lincolnshire border into tiny Rutland and the famous Barnsdale Gardens, created and popularised by TV gardener, Geoff Hamilton. Its series of thirty eight small gardens, each with a different style, offer a host of design and planting ideas. From here, we head to more Elizabethan grandeur, on an opulent scale, at Burghley

House, in time for lunch (not included). Burghley House is one of England's grandest and most important houses, with magnificent parkland (used for the annual horse trials) and stunning gardens. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 4 Wednesday 29th June 2022

Alas, it is time to head back northwest, but two final visits en-route, first of all to the famous Brightwater Gardens near Market Rasen, an eight-acre haven of beautiful gardens, wildflower meadows and woodland. Finally, to the lovely 3.5 acres at Mill Farm Gardens, lovingly created beneath the big skies of Lincolnshire with far-reaching views. A packed lunch from the hotel is included today. We depart mid-afternoon back to Edgworth with arrival scheduled for about 5.30-6pm.


